## NOTE:

- 1: The assistance can be given for the teachers who are the First Author or Corresponding Author.
- 2: The published paper which has been considered for financial assistance once cannot be claimed twice for any authorship.
- 3: One teacher will be eligible for these rewards for one financial year. If a teacher publishes Research/Review Papers more than a specified number of times, he/she will not be eligible for further rewards in that financial year. This rewards system will be freshly available in each financial year.
- 4: *For more than one author, the award is to be shared.*
- 5: *The student who is claiming for the reward must be the first or the second author.*
- 6: *The paper which has been claimed for the reward by the student author cannot be claimed by any other author ever again.*
- 7: *The student who wishes to publish an article in a nonindexed journal can publish the article in our own journal at minimal cost/free of cost.*

*Conference/FDP (Registration) National : One per faculty per year is permitted*

*International : One per faculty once in three years permitted*

### \*\*\* SEED GRANT: Grants sanctioned against the call for proposal

**Principal investigator and Co-PI are mandatory in the SEED grant scheme**

**PI and Co-PI are solely responsible for the completion of the project**

**For a 2.0 lakh seed grant: One per faculty can apply once in three years**

**Less than 1 lakh grant: One per faculty once in two years.**

Note: Interdepartmental research proposals are highly appreciated and considered

- Grant is only for faculty project proposals; Student projects are not entertained under the scheme.
- The outcome expected from the SEED grant includes the publication of research work fulfilling the criteria mentioned below/attainment of patent for the submitted research.
- For 2.0 lakhs sanctioned proposal, publication must be in Q1 journal.
- Less than 1.0 lakhs, Publication in Q2/Q3 journal is acceptable.

Financial year: 1<sup>st</sup> April to next 31<sup>st</sup> March.
