### Pipe composting in houses of Avoly panchayath

### Report

NSS unit of Nirmala College of pharmacy, have provided free pipe composts over twelve houses of Avoly Panchayat. The programme was inaugurated by the college Administrator Fr.Jos Mathai Mailadiath. The team members involved NSS coordinator Mr.Eby George, NSS unit members Mr. Bejoy Jose and Mr.Sebin Sebastian along with five selected male volunteers of NSS. The programmewas aimed not only to implement free compost, but also to create awareness about the effective composting of biodegradable waste from houses mainly kitchen wastes. A minor survey was also conducted from the houses so as to visit the houses where pipe compost is instilled. This will ensure the proper maintenance of compost on another visit. Maintaining all covid prevention protocols, the volunteers also distributed a small notice providing the guideline to improve immunity against covid protocols.

### What is Pipe/worm composting?

Pipe composting is a kind of vermin composting, often called Worm Tube Composting, carried out within a PVC tube, promoted by World Malyalee Council. This method of composting as a process of waste to wealth is big a success in states like Kerala, Karnataka. Find below a PDF for further reading. For the pipe composting method, we need three PVC pipes of 8 inch or 10 inch diameter and length of about 1.25 meters. The pipes are placed vertically, dug 25-30 cm into the ground. Initially, a small amount of cow dung and jaggery is put in with some mud. Later, only kitchen waste or wet waste is put into the pipe.
